

Back in America after 20 years in Britain, Bryson decided to re-acquaint himself with his native country by walking the 2100-mile trail from Georgia to Maine. Unfortunately, the gentle hill trails he knew in England did not begin to prepare him for the rigors of the AT; also, for some unfathomable reason, he chose as a hiking companion his irascible and gloriously out-of-shape buddy Stephen Katz.
