The story has all the best ingredients: sex and love, secrets and lies, but it is the detail from the documents that fascinates, such as Crippen's account of marital bickering that preceded his wife's disappearance, and the daily media accounts of the police net closing on the fleeing couple. This bloody history combines a gripping narrative with facts from witness statements, police reports, and the chilling words of a killer claiming So far as I know she is still alive.
