

Dear Sir: During the last week of the fourth liberty loan, while fulfilling my duties as Hold secretary for the four-minute men and the Council of National Defense, I, accompanied by 20 returned wounded American soldiers, canvassed the patrons of the Ritz-Carlton Hotel in furtherance of the bond sales. Several directors and officers of your corporation were present and, realizing the psychological effect these returned wounded soldiers would have on the workingnien of the Hog Island shipyard, I was approached with a proposition to devote my time toward securing the discharge of a number of such soldiers that they might be brought to the shipyard and put to work at various trades and occupations. On October 23 I proceeded to Washington with Mr. E. N. Moore, of the labor control of the A. I. S. C, and, with the assistance of Mr. Pizzini, an official of the American Red Cross, we interviewed the Secretary of War s office, and particularly Mr. Stanley King, secretary to Mr. Baker, who indorsed the idea heartily aud directed us to secure the indorsement of various boards and committees already interested in the returned wounded soldiers welfare. This idea was enthusiastically received by the Federal Board for Vocational Education, the committee on development battalions, an Army organization composed of two civilians and...
