Guided by a fervent strain of idealism, Gregers endeavors to reveal the truth to Hjalmar, and thereby free him from the mendacity which surrounds him. To that end, Gregers takes up residence in the Ekdal Home. He meddles in the affairs of a strange family, producing disastrous results. Figuratively speaking, he lives in a house whose closets are full of skeletons. Over the course of the play the many secrets that lie behind the Ekdals apparently happy home are revealed to Gregers, who insists on pursuing the absolute truth, or the Summons of the Ideal. This family has achieved a tolerable modus vivendi by ignoring the skeletons (among the secrets: Gregers father may have impregnated his servant Gina then married her off to Hjalmar to legitimize the child, and Hjalmar s father has been disgraced and imprisoned for a crime the elder Werle committed.) and by permitting each member to live in a dreamworld of his own-the feckless father believing himself to be a great...
